

Also, the day after the long trip from Amuria to Kasana, you rode back in to Kampala in the morning to buy more supplies, came back to Kasana around midday, and again treated patients the rest of the day. To the doctors and all the rest of the team, thank you for all of your very hard work. Among other things, you kept the generator running, organized patients, dispensed drugs, taught dental hygiene, pulled teeth, sterilized equipment, assisted the dentists—with all of you putting in very long hours for many days, and treating an average of 40+ patients each day, and probably more than that in Amuria and Kobwin! Thank you too for working in cramped conditions in Kobwin and Amuria, and even under a tree...until the downpour happened!

Our hearts are full with the love the Lord has displayed to us through you. May His great blessings be on each one of you.
